## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63957 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Larry F. Hyatt of PO Box 5016, Charleston, Oregon 97420, phone 888-9188, for the use of the waters of Big Creek, tributary of Pacific Ocean, a reservoir constructed under Permit R-5579, and three additional reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-63956,\* for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 27, 1982 for 7.14 cubic feet per second of water and June 28, 1983 for 0.23 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 7.37 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2232.7 feet South and 1210.4 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9; Dam 1 - 2905.45 feet South and 187.85 feet West of the Northeast Corner of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 16; Dam 2 - 3120.11 feet South and 818.77 feet East of the Northeast Corner of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, all in Township 26\*\*

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 ~~Extended to October 1, 1989~~

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 ~~Extended to October 1, 1989~~
