## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64920 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lowell M. Eiffert of Route 3, Box 68, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-5360 or 938-7400, for the use of the waters of West Prong Little Walla River,

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1320 feet North and 900 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 22, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM Section 22 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 23.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
