## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64921 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert F. Olson of PO Box 847, Summer Lake, Oregon 97640, phone 943-3277, for the use of the waters of Spring Stream, tributary Summer Lake,

for the PURPOSE of fish propagation and irrigation, being 5.0 cubic foot per second for fish propagation and 0.9 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.9 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2220 feet North and 1100 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 34, being within the NW I/4 SW I/4 of Section 34, Township 30 South, Range 16 East, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
