PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64948 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clinton E. Atherton of PO Box 126, Riddle, Oregon 97469, phone 874-2772, for the use of the waters of Cow Creek, tributary South Umpqua,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 23, 1983 for 0.009 cubic foot per second of water and April 14, 1983 for 0.001 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 360 feet South and 820 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 24 and 23, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 24 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 one-half acre garden

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
