PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64999 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Shockman Brothers Construction Company of PO Box 101, Hermiston, Oregon 97838, phone 567-8474, for the use of the waters of Umatilla River, tributary Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of washing gravel in a gravel mining operation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 8, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: North 76 degrees 45 minutes 56 seconds East 2913.19 feet from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 3 North, Range 29 East, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North, Range 27 East, WM Section 27 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Ind. - Gravel Washing SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Ind. - Gravel Washing

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to any stream.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
