PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65016 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arthur H. Patterson, Jr., of 636 Hillside Avenue, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 884-3646, for the use of the waters of Rogue River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1620 feet South and 120 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 all of Section 4, Township 31 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 domestic use for one Township 31 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 3 family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
