PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63265 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Thayer Cattle Co., Kenneth Thayer of Route 3, Box 6089, Ontario, Oregon 97914, phone 889-5774, for the use of the waters of Canyon 1 and Thayer Drain, being 5.6 cubic feet per second from Canyon 1 and 1.94 cfs from Thayer Drain, tributaries of Snake River for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 16, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 7.54 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Canyon 1 - 451 feet South and 697 feet West; Thayer Drain - 576 feet South and 105 feet West, both from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 8, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
