PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63484 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl M. Fullen of 3520 East Elma Street, Camarillo, California 93010, phone 805-482-8574, for the use of the waters of Hubbard Creek and Umpqua River, being 0-019 cubic foot per second primary supply from Hubbard Creek and 0.028 cfs supplemental supply* for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 31. 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.028 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Point of Diversion 1 - 1610 feet North and 2030 feet East from the W 1/4 of Section 21; Point of Diversion 2 - 1720 feet North and 2350 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 21; both being within Government Lot 3, Section 21, Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

from Umpqua River provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 0.028 cfs, tributary of Pacific Ocean

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 21 Lot 3 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.7 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Lot 3 1.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 8, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
