## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63496 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert L. Miller of PO Box 848, Veneta, Oregon 97487, phone 935-3570, for the use of the waters of Fern Ridge Reservoir, constructed under Permit R-1625, tributary of Long Tom River

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 19, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 880 feet North and 840 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 20 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 3-07-10-W0504 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 8, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
