PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64795** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Juniper Flat District Improvement Co. of Route 1, Box 13, Maupin, Oregon 97037, phone 328-6349**, for the use of the waters of Clear Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply of water from Clear Creek to be made up by appropriation * for the PURPOSE of **Irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 21, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **2.98 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Clear Creek - 610 feet South and 2380 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 9 East, WM; Frog Creek - 700 feet South and 900 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34; Clear Lake Reservoir - 1389.6 feet South and 480.27 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 ****

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * **from Frog Creek and Clear Creek Reservoir allowed by Decree of Circuit Court for Wasco County and Clear Lake Reservoir Enlargement constructed under Permit R-2106, tributaries of White River**
- ** **SE 1/4, Section 32, both being within Township 4 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to **1/40** of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3.0** acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 8, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
