PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65496** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **George E. and Marian M. Casebier of PO Box 1117, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, phone 592-2949, for the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River, tributary of Illinois River**

for the PURPOSE of **Irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.11 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use for one family**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 2, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.115 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **85 feet North and 260 feet West from the Southeast Corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21; being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM	Section 21 SW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.45 acres
	Section 28 NW 1/4 NE 1/4	3.1 acres and domestic for one family

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 8, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
