PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65048 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Todd Hartman of Golden Leaf Farm, 1086 Main Camas Road, Camas Valley, Oregon 97416, phone 445-2377 for the use of the waters of the Umpque River, tributary of Pacific Ocean,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 27, 1983 for 0.28 cfs and June 3, 1983 for 0.03 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1600 feet North and 180 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 25 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.0 acre
Township 25 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 30 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 acres
NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 17, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
