PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65069 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clayton H. Douglas of 497 Mansfield Street, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 726-2836, for the use of the waters of McKenzie River, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and operation of a heat pump, being 0.01 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.022 cfs for heat pump

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 4, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.032 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 475 feet South and 712 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 19, being within the NE I/4 NE I/4 of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 1 East, WM Section 19 NE 1/4

Section 19 NE I/4 NE I/4 0.251 acre NE I/4 NE I/4 Heat pump

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 17, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
