PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65080** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David H. and Regina M. Marks of Route 3, Box 3819, Hermiston, Oregon 97838, phone 567-8244, for the use of the waters of Hat Rock Drain, a tributary of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 11, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed i.0 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 920 feet North and 1550 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21; Diversion 2 - 1700 feet North and 1200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, both being within Township 5 North, Range 29 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 North, Range 29 East, WM Section 21 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 30.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
