PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65089** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary Keltner Rounds of Route 3, Box 1545, Asea, Oregon 97324, phone 486-4371, for the use of the waters of Wilkinson Creek and an unnamed stream, tributaries to Lobster Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.038 cubic foot per second of water from Wilkinson Creek for irrigation and 0.005 cfs from the unnamed stream for domestic use that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.043 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1170 feet South and 1120 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 35, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
