PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65136 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bert and Emelyn Christensen of 337 Northwest 23rd Street, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, phone 753-3788, for the use of the waters of Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit R-1625,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 20, 1983

of and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.16acre-foot stored water only

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 465 feet South and 1380 feet West from the C 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM. in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 20 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.16 acre Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 3-07-10-W0481 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
