PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

65162 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65 162 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert Paul Theiss of 91625 West Fork Road, Deadwood, Oregon 97430, phone 964-3251, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Schwartz Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 1, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water

530 feet North and 780 feet West from the Southeast Corner The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 330 Teet North and 700 Teet west into the 300 teets of Section 35, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 16 South, Range 9 West, WM Section 35

NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
