## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65178 INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Phillip Murphy of Box 114, Monument, Oregon 97864, phone 934-2421, for the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek and North Fork John Day River, a tributary of John Day River, being 0.85 cubic feet per second of water from \* for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 7, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.85 Cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Cottonwood Creek - 3100 feet South and 40 feet West from the C1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the NE1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 12; North Fork John Day River - 970 feet South and 340 feet East from the C1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, both being within Township 9 South, Range 27 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* Cottonwood Creek and 0.075 cfs from North Fork John Day River, provided the total diverted shall not exceed 0.85 cfs,

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 22, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 \$5.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
