This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64395 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued tenited States, Malheur National Forest, 139 Northeast Dayton Street, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731, for the use of the waters of eleven unnamed tributaries to Canyon Creek-Mainstem John Day River, for the PURPOSE of stock watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 4, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second from each source provided the total quantity diverted from the combined sources shall not exceed 0.015 cfs
