PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65198** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Peter W. Schoeningh, Jr.**, of Route 1, Box 116, Haines, Oregon 97833, phone 856-3488, for the use of the waters of an unnamed slough, a tributary of Warm Springs Creek,

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 16, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.75 cubic feet per second of water**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 120 feet South and 2150 feet West; Diversion 2 - 330 feet South and 300 feet West; Diversion 3 - 320 feet South and 5 feet East all from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within the Diversion 1 - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Diversion 2 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4; Diversion 3 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4 all in Section 7, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Baker.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 2, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
