PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65218 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Daniel A. Seaman of 28024 Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway, Cottage Grove, Oregon 97424, phone 942-9368, for the use of the waters of the North Fork Siusiaw River, a tributary of Siusiaw River for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 22, 1983 for 0.81 cubic foot per second of water and September 2, 1983 for 0.09 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.90 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 250 feet South and 2696 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 13, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 20 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 13 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 6.57 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 35.0 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 24.75 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.68 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 \$5.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 . Extended to October 1987
