### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65225** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Harry C. May of 215 Carlson Heights, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-6235, for the use of the waters of a spring,**

for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 24, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second of water**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **910 feet North and 230 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 25 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 25 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 12 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 2, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
