PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

65231 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65231 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wayne Emerson Truax of 21900 Southeast Donna Court, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 658-4553, for the use of the waters of Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 27, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2250 feet North and 850 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 23, Township 35 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 7 West, WM

Section 23 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one

family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
