PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

65081 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65081 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert and Carol Foley of 182 Old Cabin Road, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-3731, for the use of the waters of Little River and an unnamed stream, a tributary of Little

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.125 cubic foot per second from Little River for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from the unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation from* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 12, 1983 for use of water from the unnamed stream and September 27, 1983 for use of water from Little River

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Little River) - 1100 feet South and 1870 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream) - 2640 feet South and 1940 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 34, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, both within Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Little River for domestic use.

Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 34 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
