PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65194 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Greg Ballard of Route 1, Box 122-D, Gaston, Oregon 97119, phone 357-5993, for the use of the waters of Johnson Creek and a reservoir, a tributary of Tualatin River, to be constructed under Application R-66011, Permit R-8897,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and container nursery operation; being 0.07 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.05 cfs for container nursery operation.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion I - 1820 feet South and 460 feet West; Diversion 2 - 1740 feet South and 960 feet West, both from the Southwest corner of Tupper DLC 42, both being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, Township I South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 23 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.0 acre SW 1/4 NE 1/4 4.48 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for water legally stored.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 . Extended to October 1987
