PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65253 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 65253 limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John C. Nelson of 269 Bellino Drive, Pacific Palisades, Califonia 90272, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under

for the PURPOSE of irrigation, supplemental irrigation and domestic use for one family being 0.04 cubic foot per second of water from Applegate River for irrigation, 6.0 acre-feet from Applegate Lake Reservoir for supplemental irrigation, and 0.005 cfs for domestic use that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 1, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.045 cubic foot per second from Applegate River and 6.0 acre-feet annually from Applegate Lake Reservoir

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 360 feet North and 1450 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM; Applegate Lake Dam - SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, both in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM

Section 28 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.5 acres

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 6.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4

primary supplemental domestic use for one family

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 3-07-10-W0482 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 35.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
