PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66058 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dave H. Brooks, dba Brookhill Farms of Oregon, Route 1, Box 906, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-9296, for the use of the waters of three reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-65269, Permit 8895, tributaries of Crooked Creek, being 1.6 acre-feet from* for the PURPOSE of temperature control (supplemental)

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.1 af only

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Reservoir 2 - 1166 feet North and 1856 feet West from the NE Corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18; Reservoir 6 - 922 feet North and 140 feet East from the NE Corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18; Reservoir 7 - 656 feet North and 563 feet East from the NE Corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Reservoir 2; 1.5 af from Reservoir 6 and 1.0 af from Reservoir 7,

of Section 18, all within Township 29 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost control) on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
