PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65284** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Steven Leonard Kuntz of Route 1, Box 1180, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 396-5291, for the use of the waters of Calcos Creek, a tributary of Coquille River,**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 8, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.055 cubic foot per second of water**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 515 feet North and 110 feet West from the Southeast Corner of 13, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM; Diversion 2 - 220 feet North and 325 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 18, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 18 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 domestic use
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 acres**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 6, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
