## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65293** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Charles J. and Shirley L. Schubert of 4235 SW Hume Street, Portland, Oregon 97219, phone 244-8568 or 646-7137, for the use of the waters of North Fork Nehalem River, a tributary of Nehalem River,** for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 12, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second of water**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **652 feet South and 917 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 4 North, Range 9 West, WM Section 32 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 6, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
