## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65294 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Paul M. and Marcella Dailey of Route 3, Box 133, Reedsport, Oregon 97467, phone 271-2534, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Smith River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 680 feet North and 1900 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 34, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 20 South, Range 10 West, WM Section 34 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 6, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
