PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65296 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stanley E. and Margo L. Tenold of 22654 Oak Crest Street, Cupertino, California 95014, phone (415)962-8199, for the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek, a tributary of Myrtle Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use and 0.135 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 13, 1983 for 0.095 cfs and August 11, 1983 for 0.045 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 350 feet North and 1200 feet West; Diversion 2 - 425 feet North and 600 feet West both from the Southeast Corner of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 13 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 7.34 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.61 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 6, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 36.
