## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61870 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

This permit is issued to Grace and James URI, for TE-TA-MA Truth Foundation Family of Uri, Incorporated of PO Box 1147, Ashland, Oregon 97520, for the use of the waters of a spring, Everygreen Creek, Reservoir 1 and Reservoir 2, a tributary of Evergreen Spring Creek/Rogue\* for the PURPOSE of irrigation and beautification, being 0.013 cubic foot per second of water from Everygreen Spring Creek for irrigation, 0.01 cfs from spring for maintaining water fall foundation for beautification, 0.01 cfs from Evergreen Spring Creek for maintaining\*\*
that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 8, 1981 for irrigation and May 3, 1983 for beautification

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.043 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring Diversion Point A - 915 feet North and 146 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 17; Irrigation Pump, Diversion Point B - 695 feet North and 90 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 17; Reservoir 1, Diversion Point C - 725 feet North and 76 feet West from Center Corner of Section 17; Reservoir 2, Diversion Point D - 700 feet North and 90 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 17, all being within the SE 1/4\*\*\* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

River, to be constructed under Application R-67349, Permit R-8901,

Reservoir I for beautification, and 0.01 cfs from Evergreen Spring Creek for maintaining Reservoir 2 for beautification.

\*\*\* NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

Township 33 South, Range 2 East, WM Section 17 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Waterfall/Fountain

Beautification SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.02 acre irrigation NW 1/4 Maintain Reservoir 1 SE 1/4

SE 1/4 NW I/4 Maintain Reservoir 2

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
