PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65329 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jimmle H. and Gail E. Smith of PO Box 66, Drain, Oregon 97435, phone 836-7158, for the use of the waters of Elk Creek, a tributary of Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 19, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 920 feet South and 840 feet West; Diversion 2 - 960 feet South and 920 feet West both from the Northeast Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 22 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 22 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 13 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86
