PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65332 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John Wetle of 616 Vicksburg Avenue, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 382-0380, for the use of the waters of Tooze Spring or Metolius River, a tributary of Deschutes; being 0.01 cubic foot per second from either source provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed* for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 21, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Tooze Spring - 80 feet North and 340 feet East from the Northwest Corner of NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, being within SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 12 South, Range 9 East, WM; Metolius River - 170 feet South and 530 feet East from the Northwest Corner of NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 13 South, Range 9 East WM, in the County of** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* 0.01 cfs,

Section 3 NE 1/4 NE 1/

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
