## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65516 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William R. Jr. and W.R. Reed of PO Box 218, Sisters, Oregon 97759, phone 549-6000, for the use of the waters of Cold Springs and Trout Creek, a tribitary of Squaw Creek Basin, being 3.2 cubic feet per second from Cold Springs with any deficiency in the available\* for the PURPOSE of Irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 9, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.2 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Springs) - 2000 feet North and 2700 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 9 East; Diversion 2 (Trout Creek) - 3000 feet North and 2500 feet East of the Southwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 15 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* supply from Cold Springs to be made up by diversion from Trout Creek

Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM Section 6 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 40.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4 40.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 40.0 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 . Extended to October 1987 Extended to October 1, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **36**. Extended to October 1, 1989 Extended to October 1, 1990
