PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66702 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William H. Tucker of 24805 South Raney Lane, Estacada, Oregon 97023, phone 630-3989, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tribitary of Clear Creek,

for the PURPOSE of maintenance of reservoir to be constructed under Application R-66701, Permit R-8900 for recreation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet North and 1430 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 4 East, WM Section 9 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Recreation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
