### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65468** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Gordon Haynes for Deschutes National Forest, Route 3, Box 422, McMinnville, Oregon 97128, phone 472-5776**, for the use of the waters of **Metolius River**, a tributary of **Deschutes River**, for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 28, 1983 for 0.000828 cubic foot per second; August 16, 1983 for 0.009172 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **2350 feet North and 840 feet West from the Section Corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 20, 1984** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1986** .
