PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 654.79 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerry L. Killingsworth of 2497 Lakeshore Drive, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-6975, for the use of the waters of Foley Gulch, a tributary of Coyote Creek,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water for domestic and 0.013 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 29, 1983 for 0.01 cfs and September 7, 1983 for 0.008 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.018 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2620 feet North and 1040 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 24, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 24 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.0 acre Domestic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
