PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65487** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Charles O. Bennett, Jr.** for **U.S. Deschutes National Forest, 1057 Northshire Court, NE, Salem, Oregon 97303, phone 393-7750, for the use of the waters of Metolius River, provided the total diverted shall not exceed 355 gallons per day, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 1, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.25 gallons per minute**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1030 feet South and 2000 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 10 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use
Lot 10 Tract H**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
