PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65509 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John Packwood of Adrian, Oregon 97901, for the use of the waters of Imbler Drain, a tributary of Snake River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 2, 1983 for 1.7 cubic feet per second and December 2, 1983 for 0.4 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.1 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South 68 degrees 34 minutes East 1397 feet from the Southwest Corner of Section 18, being within the Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 47 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 21 South, Range 47 East, WM Section 18 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) 0.4 acre Lot 5

Lot 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) 15-2 acres Lot 7

(SW 1/4 SW 1/4) 38.0 acres (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) 31.0 acres

Lot 8

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 3, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86,
