PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65527 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of 506 Southwest Mill Street, Portland, Oregon 97208, phone 229-5701, for the use of the waters of North Santiam River, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of to improve water quality for rearing fall chinook salmon

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 10, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 50.0 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 140 feet South and 30 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Linn.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range I West, WM Section 15 NW I/4 SW I/4 Water supply for lower pond

Actual construction work shall begin on or before ${\bf January~3,~1985}$ reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
