PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65569 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Claude E. and Gwendolyn H. Crane of 2884 Hubbard Creek Road, Umpqua, Oregon 97486, phone 459-3734, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Coles Valley Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 16, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1550 feet South and 1540 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 27 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 6, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
