PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65570 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert N. Gordon and/or Barbara L. Gordon of Route 2, Box 244, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-6607, for the use of the waters of Clark's Branch, a tributary of South Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 16, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 675 feet North and 160 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 1 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 acres Section 2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.8 acre

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 6, 1985** reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
