PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65575** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Russell O'Conner of 3341 Oak Crest Drive, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-2503, for the use of the waters of Gales Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River,**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.07 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 18, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.075 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **176 feet South and 90 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Wm. J. Bell DLC 57, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 provided further water shall not be appropriated (from direct flow) during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year (except for human and livestock consumption) reservoir = each year, except for stored water,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 6, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
