## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65576 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Daryl S. Alosa of PO Box 952, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 496-3627, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of North Umpqua,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.225 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.23 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 860 feet North and 420 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 3, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 3 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 18.0 acres and domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Sanuary 6, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19  $^{85}$  .

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19  $^{86}$  .
