PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65613** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Charles L. Vaughn** of PO Box 641, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-5217, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir, a tributary of Lookingglass Creek, to be constructed under Application R-65612, Permit R-8992, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and stock water, being 0.53 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock water**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 25, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.54 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 100 feet South and 600 feet East; Diversion 2 - 500 feet South and 650 feet East both from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under R-8992 provided further that during the period from June 1 through September 30 of each year the waters of Lookingglass Creek and tributaries are classified only for stockwater of less than 5000 gallons per day per appropriation; stored water may be used at any time.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 6, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1986**.
