PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **66009** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Eric S. Prior** on behalf of **Korru-tek (USA), Inc.**, of 830 Signal Way, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-7556, for the use of the waters of **Priorli Creek**, two unnamed creeks and a reservoir, a tributary of **Morgan Creek**, to be constructed under Application R-66008,* for the PURPOSE of **for fish culture, wash water and irrigation, being 0.68 cfs from Priorli Creek for maintenance of a reservoir and fish culture, 0.01 cfs from Unnamed Stream 1 for fish culture, 0.01 cfs from Unnamed Stream 2 for fish culture, 0.01 cfs from Priorli Creek for wash water**** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 9, 1983 for 0.71 cfs and October 24, 1983 for 0.01 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.72 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 (Priorli Creek) - 1090 feet North and 235 feet East; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream 1) - 1220 feet North and 190 East; Diversion 3 (Unnamed Stream 2) - 1050 feet North and 35 feet East** all from the Southwest Corner, Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of **Coos**.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Permit R-9093, being 0.70 cubic foot per second from Priorli Creek, 0.01 cfs from Unnamed Stream 1 and 0.01 cfs from Unnamed Stream 2,
- ** and 0.01 cfs from Priorli Creek for irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 16, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86** .
