PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66012 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Denald Joseph Callaghan and Zelma A. Callaghan of 427 South H Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-3620, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Ward Creek, a tributary of Deep Creek, a tributary of Warner Lakes, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and recreation; being 0.10 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for recreation (maintenance of a swimming pool)

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 9, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 500 feet South and 1980 feet East from the Northwest Corner, Section 29, being within the NE I/4 NW I/4 of Section 29, Township 40 South, Range 22 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South, Range 22 East, WM Section 20 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 Irrigation SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Recreation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **january 16, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
