PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66019 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Susan Comerford and William Comerford of 497 Lone Rock Road, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-0105, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed G015 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1675 feet South and 175 feet East from the Northwest Corner, Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 16 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.17 acres and Domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 16, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19, 86.
