PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66020 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles M. Kendrick of 1714 Williams Highway, Grants Pass, Oregon 97527, phone 479-3104, for the use of the waters of Murphy Creek and a spring, a tributaries of Applegate River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from spring for domestic use for one family and 0.01 cfs from Murphy Creek for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 13, 1983 for 0.01 cfs and October 24, 1983 for 0.005 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion | (Murphy Creek) - 735 feet North and 215 feet East; Diversion 2 (Spring) - 781 feet North and 280 feet East both from the Southwest Corner of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 36 SE I/4 NW I/4 Demestic use for one family
SE I/4 NW I/4 0.5 acre Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable retation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **january 16, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
